Babylonia

Assyria

- vicious warriors in search of riches
- City of Nineveh became famous for its Library
 - Crossroads of trade
 - Invented battering ram
 - Empires made rich by Conquest and trade
- Societies were eventually Conquered by others
- Vulnerable to invaders, Assyrians decided to attack
 - Empire reached across The Fertile Crescent and Nile River to the Persian Gulf
- Destroyed by Medes and Chaldeans in 612 B.C.
 - Built grand cities where Culuture and learning were highly Valued
- Rose again about 1,000 years later
 - As center of learning and science
- Destroyed and conquered by about 1600 B.C.
- Created by Hammurabi by uniting cities of Sumer
